Our College is adopting a new form of communication called 'School Stream'. The app is free and must be downloaded onto a smart phone device.

As parents you will be in full control of what you see and what notifications you receive. There are over 100 languages available to choose from allowing all our College parents to be kept up to date.

As of **Term 2** 2019 our College will move to a paperless school, meaning that all communications will be made through the 'School Stream App'. In preparation for this we are asking all families to have download the School Stream app onto your mobile device. It is expected that all families will have downloaded the app and created an account by the end of this term. An instruction sheet for both Apple and Android devices is available from the office if you still require assistance.
