



### Principal's Piece

What a privilege it is to be part of such a fantastic learning community. I am so proud of our students and staff and all the things that are happening in our school. Today, we had a visit from the "Robot Man" who ran a Robotics Workshop with Grade 2 - 6 students. I witnessed VCAL students organising an excursion to Melbourne as well as spending time building picnic tables to enhance our College grounds. Yesterday a teacher was running an impressive demonstration of a chemical reaction that creates a product of molten iron after creating a fountain of sparks. Students have been engaging in activities to prepare for the College Production (which I am very excited about). We have had students out at interschool sports events and visits from multiple guest speakers. Last weekend we had a group at a retreat for the Certificate 3 in Christian Ministry and Theology program and last week we had a group on an Outdoor Education camp in the high country. On top of all that there are many exciting learning opportunities happening in each and every classroom. Our young people are truly blessed with great learning opportunities.

We are well underway in planning for 2020. Our second Year 7 class is filling fast, as is the Prep group. If you know of families interested in Prep or Year 7 for 2020, please encourage them to get in quick.

In line with planning for 2020, we recently advertised for 3 teachers to help with our continued growth. We are seeking a Secondary Maths Teacher, Secondary Maths/Science teacher and a Primary Teacher. One of the things that I am very impressed about is the heart and attitude of our students. Our SRC group, along with our College Captains (Kia and Jonah) have been organising an event to raise awareness of homelessness. This event encompasses a combined chapel, casual clothes day, BBQ lunch, after school activities for our secondary students and a sleep out (in cardboard boxes) for our senior secondary students. This event is being organised by our students for our students and is great example of student leadership in action.

I am constantly reminded of the need to be practical in our Christian faith, and this homelessness event is a great reminder of putting our faith into actions.
